The City Council shall convene into executive session pursuant to the Texas Government Code, §551.071 (Consultation with Attorney) to seek legal advice from the City Attorney and to deliberate and discuss pending or contemplated litigation relating to the Comfort Suites Ray Hubbard hotel and Prayosha Enterprises.
