7B. Consider a resolution approving a contract for pavement analysis.

Consider action to approve a resolution approving the engagement of H2O Partners/Roadway Asset Services (RAS) for the total amount of \$128,998 to perform a Pavement Assessment for the City of Rowlett, to include capturing 360-degree photos of all City Streets and Alleys, capturing City assets in the right-of-way, and providing GIS layers of all information captured.

7C. Consider a resolution approving a depository and merchant services.

The subject property is located approximately 1,050 feet northeast of the intersection of Lakeview Parkway and Dalrock Road, being a portion of Lot 3, Block A of the 8900 Lakeview Parkway Addition, in the City of Rowlett, Rockwall County, Texas.
