with the Merritt Road 36-Inch and 30-Inch Waterline Project and authorizing the Mayor to execute the necessary documents for said services.

# 7C. Consider action approving a tree removal permit.

Consider and take action on a request by Danny Giesbrecht, 151 Coffee, on behalf of property owner Lakeview Parkway Ventures, LLC., for approval of a Tree Removal Permit application on a portion of an approximately 5.52-acre property zoned General Commercial/Retail (C-2) District. The subject property is located approximately 360 feet east of the intersection of Lakeview Parkway and Rowlett Road, being a portion of Lot 2, Block 1 of the A.S.P.I Addition, in the City of Rowlett, Dallas County, Texas.
