7B. Consider action to amend rental housing regulations including new short-term rental and hotel/motel.

Consider and take action to approve an ordinance amending Code of Ordinances Article XI, Rental Housing, Division 1 and 2, and adopt new standards for Division 3, 4, 5 and 6.

7C. Consider amending the Master Fee Schedule.

Consider and take action approving a resolution amending the Master Fee Schedule for rate and fee changes to Building and Building Regulations.

Consider action to approve a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute a License Agreement with Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) for the construction, installation, operation, and maintenance of one 8-inch PVC wastewater main encased within a 15-inch steel casing pipe across and under the DART railroad tracks and right-of-way near Edgewater Drive.
