Presentations must remain pertinent to the issues being discussed. A person may not assign a portion of his or her time to another speaker.

- **8A.** Consider action to approve a resolution appointing Brian Funderburk as the City Manager of the City of Rowlett, Texas under Section 4.01 of the Rowlett City Charter; approving an employment agreement for such appointment; and authorizing the Mayor to execute the necessary documents.
- **8B.** Conduct a public hearing and consider an ordinance approving a Planned Development Ordinance for property generally located west of Liberty Grove Road and east of Larkin Lane and Berryman Road, being 69.761 + acres, for a zoning change from the current Single Family 40 and Mixed Use North Shore zoning district to a Planned Development Zoning Overlay district for the purpose of primarily developing a single family residential development with ancillary garden office uses. - **8C.** Conduct a public hearing and consider an ordinance approving a rezoning request for property located at 3100 Merritt Road, to rezone from the existing Planned Development (ORD-052-06) Zoning District to the Urban Village Form Based Zoning District for the purposes of building a pedestrian-oriented, multi-family neighborhood to be governed by the City of Rowlett's Form Based Code.
