## 10. CONSENT AGENDA

The following may be acted upon in one motion. A City Council member or a Citizen may request items be removed from the Consent Agenda for individual consideration.

- **10A.** Consider approving minutes from the July 10 11, 2010 Council Retreat Meeting, the July 20, 2010 Regular Council Meeting and the July 27, 2010 Special Council Meeting.
- 10B. Consider a resolution authorizing the final acceptance of public improvements for Lighthouse Baptist Church, Lot 2, Block A of the Heritage Addition, located at 8000 Miller Road, Rowlett, Texas.
- **10C.** Consider a resolution expressing official intent to reimburse costs of two E-One Typhoon Pumper Fire Engines in the amount of eight hundred eighty-one thousand six hundred seventy-seven dollars and eighty cents (\$881,677.80) to be paid from General Fund balance at receipt.
- 10D. Consider a resolution awarding a bid for the ten-year lease purchase financing of two E-One Typhoon Pumper Fire Engines to SunTrust Equipment Finance & Leasing Corporation in the amount of one million one thousand one hundred eighty-six dollars and ninety cents (\$1,001,186.90) and authorizing the execution of the necessary documents for said purchase.
- 10E. Consider a resolution authorizing the third successive one-year option with Pattillo, Brown, & Hill, L.L.P. for independent auditing services in an amount not to exceed sixty-eight thousand dollars (\$68,000) for the City of Rowlett; authorizing the City Manager to execute said engagement letter attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.
- **10F.** Consider a resolution authorizing golf course expenditures to purchase and install re-circulating pumps and fountains as recommended by the Golf Advisory Board to American Golf Corporation in the amount of fifty-nine thousand fourteen dollars and sixty-five cents (\$59,014.65).

If a Public Hearing is listed, the City Council will conduct such public hearing to receive comments concerning the specific items listed in the agenda. While any person with pertinent comments will be granted an opportunity to present them during the course of the hearing, the presiding officer reserves the right to restrict testimony in terms of time and repetitive content. Organizations, associations, or groups are encouraged to present their commonly held views and

identical or similar comments through a representative member when possible. Presentations must remain pertinent to the issues being discussed. A person may not assign a portion of his or her time to another speaker.

- **11A.** Continue a public hearing tabled at the May 4, 2010 City Council meeting and consider approving an ordinance amending the Master Thoroughfare Plan, Part V of the Rowlett Code of Ordinances.


